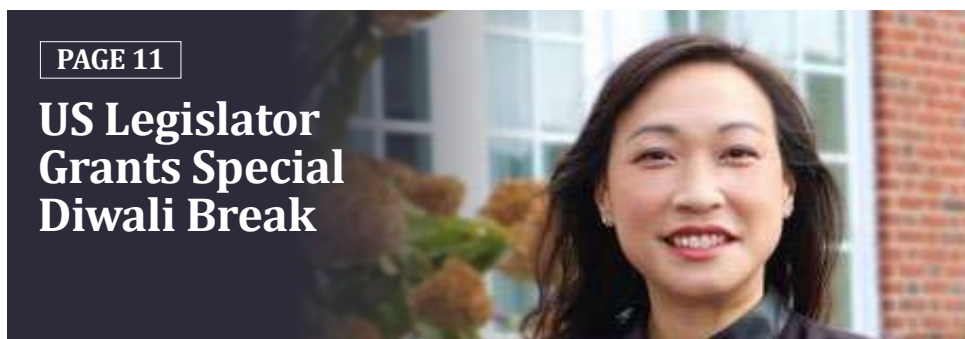

Layoffs Abound - Petition Demands Extension For H-1B Visa Holders

Two Indian-American organisations have started an online petition asking President Joe Biden to increase the grace period for H-1B visa holders from two months to a year amid widespread layoffs in the American tech industry that have left many Indian professionals without jobs.

This means that after being fired from a job, a foreign tech worker on an H-1B visa would have one year instead of the current 60 days to find a new employment before having to leave the country.

"On behalf of immigrants (from the world, mainly from India and China) as well as naturalised citizens like Indian-Americans, Founda-

tion for India and Indian Diaspora Studies and Global Technology Professionals Association (GITPRO) has submitted an appeal to the President of the United States, the Secretary of DHS (Department of Homeland Security) and the director of USCIS (US Citizenship and Immigration Services) to extend the current grace period from 60 days to 1 year (minimum 6 months)," the online petition said.

"We join the appeal and request to sympathetically consider the impact of the families on humanitarian grounds. We believe that this extension will pause this brain drain and ensure that the US will continue to be a world leader in technology and innovation. We also

request elected officials to support this extension and if needed introduce a bill in the House of Representatives," said the online petition that has been signed by more than 2,200 people so far.

According to *LayoffTracker.com*, 91,000 were laid off just in January 2023 and this number may grow in the coming months. This has a huge impact on them, and their families, especially on the H-1B holders who would need to leave the US immediately within 10 days beyond the H-1B grace period, the petition said.

In addition to the impact on them and their families, this is also a long-term impact on the talent that the US has. For example, 70 per-

cent of startup founders are immigrants. About 50 CEOs of public companies are of Indian origin. Hence, the exodus of this talent from the US is harmful for the long-term interests of the US, especially in the modern age of Artificial Intelligence competition, it said.

"The laid-off H-1B holders currently have about 60 days to find another employer to file for the H-1B transfer or leave the country. During the current economic situation, it would be impossible for these hard-working, tax-paying and talented people to get hired till the economy recovers," said the petition.

Sikhs Targeted in US Hate Crimes

Jews and Sikhs were the two most targeted religious groups in hate-motivated crime in the US in 2021, according to the annual compilation of nationwide incidents by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

A total of 1,005 hate crimes related to religion were reported in 2021, the

FBI said.

Anti-Jewish occurrences made up the majority of religion-based crime categories with 31.9%, followed by anti-Sikh incidents with 21.3%. 9.5% of hate crimes motivated by religion were anti-Muslim. 6.1% of occurrences were anti-Catholic, and 6.5% were anti-Eastern Orthodox (Russian, Greek,

or Other) incidents.

Overall, law enforcement agencies reported 7,262 total incidents and 9,024 victims, demonstrating that hate crimes remain a concern for communities across the country, the FBI said.

According to the FBI data for the year 2021, 64.8 percent of victims were targeted because of the offenders'

bias towards race/ethnicity/ancestry, which continues to be the largest bias motivation category.

At 63.2 percent of all single-bias events in 2021, anti-Black or African American hate crimes are still the most prevalent bias incident type. In addition, 4.3% of reported occurrences in 2021 were anti-Asian incidents.

US Plans New Move on H-1B Visa

The US is planning to resume "domestic visa revalidation" in certain categories on a pilot basis with the goal of scaling it up in the next few years.

"We are working in earnest on plans to restart this service for certain petition-based NIV categories, and we hope to have a pilot up and running later this year. This would eliminate the need for these applicants to travel abroad to renew visas," a State

Department spokesperson told PTI.

The State Department facilitated domestic visa

revalidation until 2004 for applicants who were physically present in the US and renewing a visa in certain petition-based non-immigrant visa (NIV) categories, the official said.

"We cannot comment on how many visa holders would be initially eligible, but the pilot would begin with a small number of cases before scaling over the following 1-2 years," said the State Department spokesperson in response to a question.

US City Bans Caste Discrimination

Seattle has become the first city in the United States to criminalise caste discrimination, following the passage of a motion by an Indian-American politician and economist to include caste in its non-discrimination policy.

The resolution moved by Kshama Sawant, an upper-caste Hindu, was approved by the Seattle City Council by six to one vote. The results of the vote could have far-reaching implications on the issue of caste discrimination in the US.

"It's official: our

movement has won a historic, first-in-the-nation ban on caste discrimination in Seattle! Now we need to build a movement to spread this victory around the country," Sawant, a city council member, said soon after the resolution was voted.

Hours before the vote, Indian-American Congresswoman Pramila Jayapal backed the proposal.

"Caste discrimination has no place in society anywhere in the world, including here in America. That is why some colleges and universities have banned it on campuses,

and workers are fighting for their rights and their dignity in cases involving caste discrimination," she said.

Equality Labs, the brain behind the anti-caste discrimination resolution in Seattle and which has been spearheading a nationwide

campaign said: "Love has won over hate as Seattle has become the first in the nation to ban caste discrimination. We have braved rape threats, death threats, disinformation, and bigotry."



Successful Rollout: NYC Launches Unique Small Business Initiative

200 Boeing for India: Joe Biden Praises Narendra Modi

The White House issued a statement from President Joe Biden on Air India's historic purchase of Boeing aircraft on February 14, 2023.

"The United States can and will lead the world in manufacturing. I am proud to announce today the purchase of over 200 American-made aircraft through a historic agreement between Air India and Boeing," the president said.

"This purchase will support over one million American jobs across 44 states, and many will not require a four-year college degree," he noted.

"This announcement also reflects the strength of the US-India economic partnership," President Biden said.

"Together with Prime Minister Modi, I look forward to deepening our partnership even further as we continue to confront shared global challenges creating a more secure and prosperous future for all of our citizens," he said.

US Legislator Grants Special Diwali Break

New York City Councilwoman Linda Lee has passed a resolution supporting the Diwali school holiday for students, New York state Assemblywoman Jenifer Rajkumar said on *Twitter*.

Sharing the video on *Twitter*, Lee wrote, "We can't fully appreciate #NYC's great diversity of culture when one-fifth of our students must choose between attending class and celebrating traditions with family. Today we passed a historic resolution to call on @NYCSchools to make Diwali an official school holiday!"

Linda Lee said, "It is an honour and privilege for Council members....and I to pass a resolution today calling upon the Department of Education to recognize Diwali as an official holiday for our students. And I also want to give a heartfelt thankyou and shout out to our amazing colleagues in this chamber who supported and co-sponsored this legislation."

"I also want to thank our state colleagues who are carrying this bill. I know we have Assembly Member Jenifer Raj Kumar who's here with us today, carrying it on the assembly side. And thank you to Senators Joseph Adavo and John Lu who are carrying it on the Senate side," Lee said.

"This is not just a victory for the hundreds of thousands of New Yorkers who are Hindu, Sikhs, Jains and Buddhists who every year have to make the difficult choice between going to school or celebrating an important holiday with their families. But it is a historic step forward for the larger AAPI community of 1.1 million New Yorkers," she said.

Vivek Ramaswamy Aims for US Presidency

The second member of the community to enter the Republican Party's presidential primaries after Nikki Haley is Indian-American tech entrepreneur Vivek Ramaswamy. He has pledged to "put merit back" and end dependence on China as he launches his 2024 presidential campaign.

"We are in the middle of this national identity crisis, Tucker, where we have celebrated our differences for so long that we forgot all the ways we are really just the same as Americans bound by a common set of ideals that set this nation into motion 250 years ago," Ramaswamy said.

"That's why I am proud to say tonight that I am running for United States president to revive those ideals in this country," he announced.

"I think we need to put 'merit' back into 'America' in every spirit of our lives," he said, adding that he will end affirmative action in "every sphere of American life."

"The people who we elect actually make them run the government rather than this cancerous federal bureaucracy. That's gonna be the heart of my message," Ramaswamy told *Fox News* in an interview.

It "has got to be our top foreign policy threat that we've gotta respond to, not pointless wars somewhere else". "That's gonna require some sacrifice. It's gonna require a declaration of independence from China and complete decoupling. And that's not gonna be easy. It's gonna require some inconvenience," he said.

Foreign policy is all about prioritisation, Ramaswamy said.

"We gotta wake up to the fact that China is violating our sovereignty and the reason, if that had been a Russian spy balloon, we'd have shot it down instantly and ratcheted up sanctions. Why didn't we do that for China?" he asked.

"The answer's simple. We depend on them for our modern way of life. This economic co-dependent relationship has to end," he said.

From UN Envoy to Possible Next POTUS: Nikki Haley

Nikki Haley, the former South Carolina governor and UN ambassador, declared her presidential candidacy, becoming the first significant competitor to officially challenge Donald Trump for the Republican nomination in 2024.

Haley released an online video saying, "It's time for a new generation of leadership." She added, "I'm Nikki Haley, and I'm running for president."

Nikki Haley spoke of her experiences growing up in the American South as a daughter of Indian immigrants in her 2020 Republican National Convention speech. "I am the proud daughter of Indian immigrants," she said. "They came to America and settled in a small Southern town. My father wore a turban. My mother wore a sari. I was a brown girl in a Black and white world. We faced discrimination and hardship, but my parents never gave in to grievance and hate," Nikki Haley told the crowd.

"I see America leading the world – in freedom and peace. But this vision isn't just mine. It's the core of our nation's history and it called to my parents over fifty years ago. I am the proud daughter of Indian immigrants," she said.

The next presidential election in the United States is scheduled for November 5, 2024. US President Joe Biden, has not declared whether he will run for re-election.

Indian American to Serve on Key US Committee

Ami Bera, an Indian-American congressman, has been elected as the Ranking Member of a key House Foreign Affairs Subcommittee that oversees the Indo-Pacific region.

"I am proud to continue my leadership on the House Foreign Affairs Committee as Ranking Member of

the Subcommittee on the Indo-Pacific. The Indo-Pacific remains the most consequential region of the world for our national security, economic interests, and values," Bera said in a statement.

"I am committed to working with my colleagues on both sides of the aisle to address the many challenges facing the region, including the

People's Republic of China's aggressive and coercive actions, the dire need for economic recovery post-pandemic, and the backsliding of democracy and human rights," he said.

Congressman Bera added, "I look forward to continuing to help lead the Subcommittee's bipartisan work towards supporting a more free, open, and prosperous Indo-Pacific."

Indian-American on Panel to Address Racism, Health Discrimination

The O'Neill-Lancet Commission on Racism, Structural Discrimination, and Global Health has chosen Priti Krishtel, an Indian-American attorney who specialises in health justice, along with four other US-based experts.

Housed at Georgetown University Law Centre in Washington, the three-year commission, co-led by UN Special Rapporteur on right to health, seeks to identify anti-racist strategies to improve health globally, according to its website.

"I'm so proud to serve on this commission that will help shape a future where all people know they can keep their loved ones healthy, where people actively shape what access to medicines looks like for their families and communities," Krishtel said in a statement.

The Commission starts with substantial evidence that communities are facing health barriers solely on

the basis of race, ethnicity, tribe, caste, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, ability, class, geography, or religion, a statement posted on the O'Neill Institute for National and Global Health website reads.

She has spent 20 years exposing structural inequities affecting access to medicines and vaccines across the Global South and in the United States. Krishtel was chosen as 2022 McArthur Fellow for exposing inequities in the patent system to increase access to affordable, life-saving medications on a global scale.

Early in her career, she worked to increase access to antiretroviral (ARV) treatments at the height of the global AIDS epidemic, and in 2006, she co-founded the Initiative for Medicines, Access, and Knowledge (I-MAK) to ensure the public had a voice in the pharmaceutical patent system.

Purdue Names Indian Professor as New Engineering Dean

Arvind Raman, a professor and administrator of Indian origin, has been appointed Dean of the esteemed College of Engineering at Purdue University, located in the US state of Indiana.

"It is truly an honour to be selected to lead the nation's largest top-ranked

college of engineering at a university with a tremendous legacy and a record of innovation and impact on a global scale," Raman was quoted as saying in the statement.

"The College of Engineering, in partnership with our faculty, students, staff, alumni and industry partners, is poised for

excellence at scale and the promise to pursue and lead truly game-changing initiatives that will impact the state, nation and world," he said.

Mark Lundstrom, a professor of electrical and computer engineering, will be replaced by Raman, whose tenure will start on April 1.

Neal Mohan, an Indian-American, will take over as YouTube's

CEO from Susan Wojcicki who has announced her resignation after 25 years with the Google-owned corporation.

Mohan joins a growing number of Indian-origin CEOs leading US-based multinational conglomerates, including Alphabet CEO Sundar Pichai, Microsoft CEO Satya Nadella, and Adobe CEO Shantanu Narayen.

In a tweet after his appointment, Mohan wrote, "Thank you, @SusanWojcicki. It's been amazing to work with you over the years. You've built YouTube into an

extraordinary home for creators and viewers. I'm excited to continue this awesome and important mission. Looking forward to what lies ahead."

Mohan had been the Chief Product Officer at YouTube for seven years before becoming the CEO.

Under Mohan's leadership, YouTube launched a number of successful products and features, including YouTube Music, YouTube TV, YouTube Premium and YouTube Shorts, wrote Susan in her farewell blog. She also credited Mohan for developing new revenue

streams for creators, such as Super Chat, Super Stickers, and channel memberships. He has also helped creators get more value out of their content by improving ad targeting and providing them with better analytics.

"Mohan has led our Trust and Safety team, ensuring that YouTube lives up to its responsibility as a global platform. He has a wonderful sense for our product, our business, our creator and user communities, and our employees. Neal will be a terrific leader for YouTube," she wrote.

Indian American Artist Behind America's First Art Tunnel

You will be astounded to see an immersive audio-visual treat when moving between terminals D and E at the George Bush International Airport in Houston, Texas.

The 240-foot-long Aquarius Art Tunnel was unveiled earlier this year.

The tunnel's bottom

is covered in coral, and Andrew Karnavas combined classical music with the artist's own contemplative underwater breath to produce the accompanying noises.

Janavi Mahimtura Folmsbee, an Indian American artist, is the mastermind behind the art experience. The Aquarius project is unique in many

UN Leads Fight Against Malnutrition with Afshan Khan

Afsan Khan, an Indo-Canadian, has been named the coordinator of the "Scaling Up Nutrition Movement," according to UN Secretary-General António Guterres.

"Afshan Khan will succeed Gerda Verburg of the Netherlands, to whom the secretary-general expresses his gratitude for her efforts and dedication in leading the Scaling Up Nutrition Movement," he said.

The Scaling Up Nutrition or SUN Movement is a

country-driven initiative led by 65 nations and four Indian states united in their mission to end all forms of malnutrition by 2030, Stéphane Dujarric, spokesperson for the secretary-general told reporters at the UN headquarters in New York.

Born in India, Khan will lead the SUN Movement Secretariat, as well as coordinate the network of SUN Government Focal Points, the movement's stakeholders, and supporters, Dujarric said.

According to a UN

statement, in her new assignment, Khan will work to ensure the execution of the Scaling Up Nutrition strategy at the global level by

building partnerships, and galvanizing engagement and commitment to end malnutrition in all its forms.

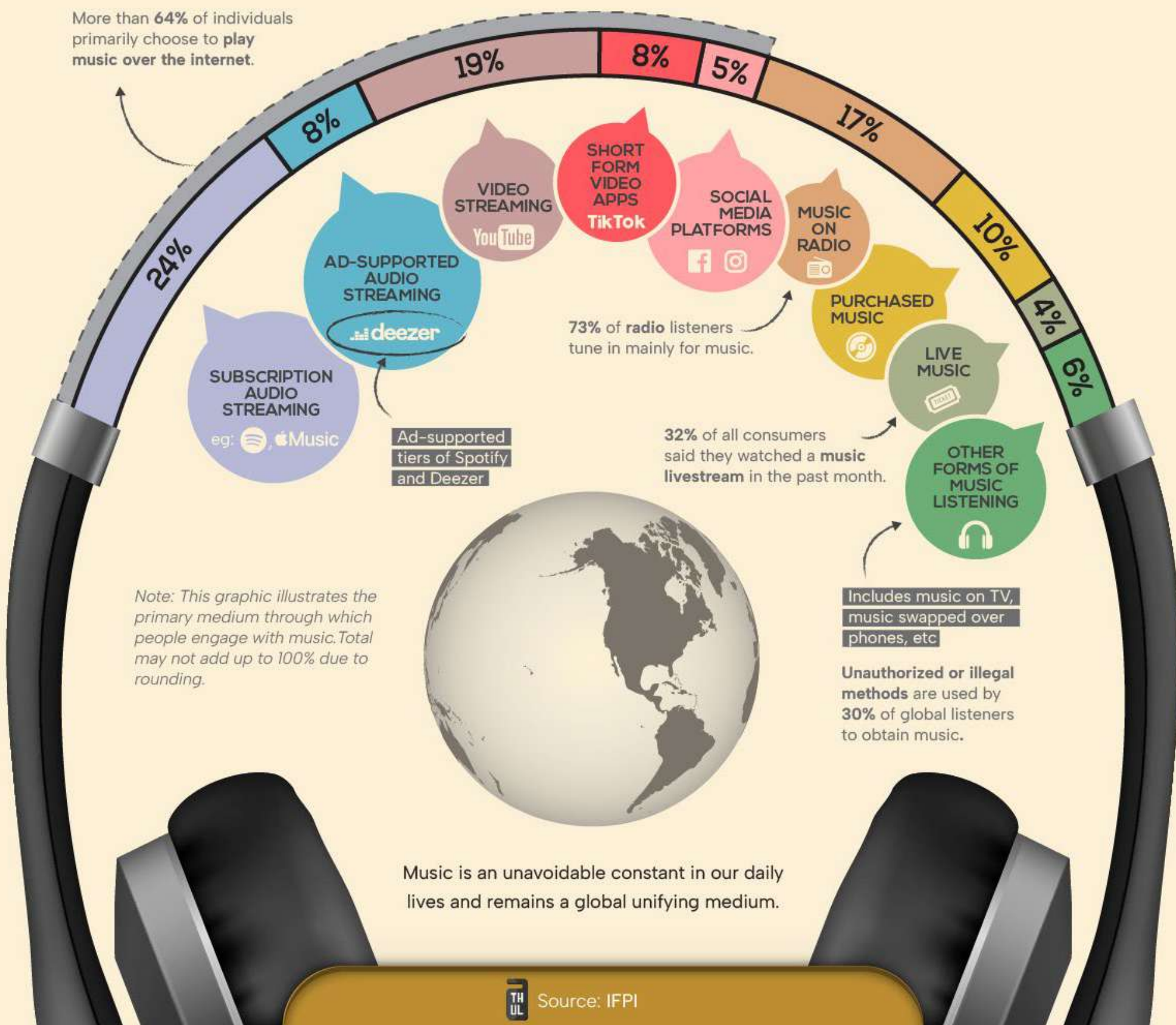

Most scenes are set in lush green surrounds with rustic places and the prominent sounds of crickets or just swishing winds surround your senses. I just loved the effect.

It has a great background score that uses minimal effects

to add to the almost scary feel at times. But don't worry, there is no horror element. Just great atmospherics, lending a superb mystifying feel.

Our heroine looks super gorgeous, and her character gradually and beautifully carves out as the story proceeds.

Amongst men, more than the lead actor, I found the actor playing Cihan more expressive.

The only drawback that the series suffers from is its slow pace. They could easily have winded things up in 6 episodes at the max. But those who have a penchant for slow burn wouldn't mind it. Interesting characters and places would keep you sufficiently occupied.

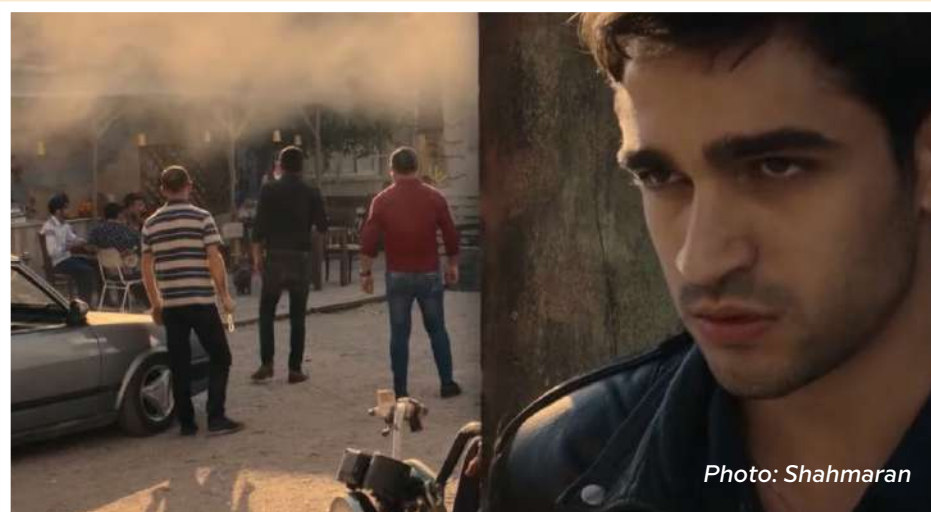

EEAO was not only my favourite film of last year, but also one of my all-time favourites. The reason being that the movie has everything that I want from a film.

The performances are such a treat.

Michelle Yeoh has added another iconic character to her filmography. The vulnerability, protectiveness, and fierceness while portraying Evelyn and her variants are simply astounding.

Waymond, portrayed by Ke Huy Quan, is my favourite character. I not only felt bad for him but also his variants. A father who is torn between his wife and daughter and who's struggling to pay off his debts. I am sure many middle-class people would relate to that.

Stephanie Hsu plays Joy who isn't the quintessential teenager you regularly see in movies. Her performance coupled with the writing elevates that character. I cannot reveal more, I don't want to spoil the experience.

The dialogues are simple yet beautiful. My favourite one is "So, Even Though You Have Broken My Heart Yet Again, I Wanted To Say, In Another Life, I Would Have Liked Just Doing Laundry And Taxes With You." This one perfectly portrays the pain, the desperation, and the incredibly emotional longing.

She leaves behind a son, Damon Welch, and daughter Latanne "Tahnee" Welch, who is also an actress.

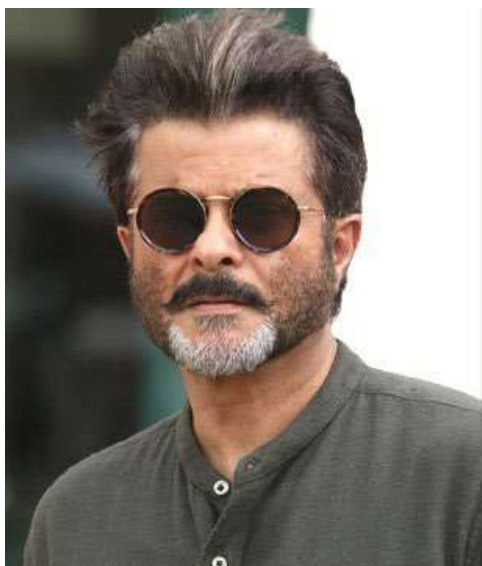
The Night Manager is the Hindi adaptation of John le Carre's novel of the same name, which also led to a

British series featuring Tom Hiddleston, Hugh Laurie, Elizabeth Debicki and Olivia Colman.

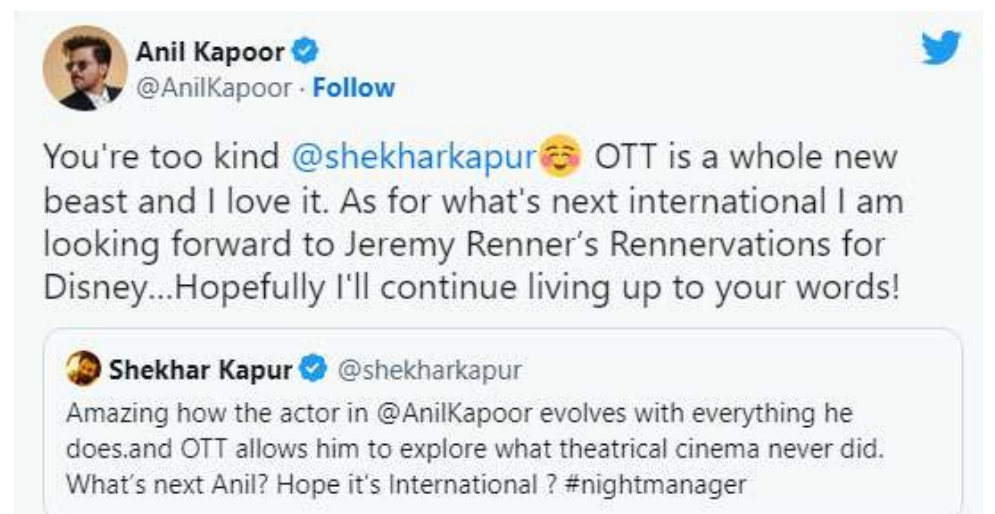
