## JaipurFoot USA, FIA Organize Multi City Free Artificial Limb Fitment Camps in India













#### FIA Honored at Pramukh Swami Maharaj Centenary Celebrations in India





### Tri-Color Unfurled at Times Square, New York for the fifth annual Flag Hoisting


